

## Guidelines for Summative Assignment S7 Presentation on a theme from Bhagavad Gita/Upanishads

For this assignment you will need to deliver a presentation on a key theme from the Bhagavad Gita or Upanishads.

The presentation must last between 10-15 minutes to be followed by a 10-minutes student teacher led Q&A/feedback session.

For the presentation you must:

- Outline your theme
- Discuss how the theme has contemporary relevance
- Refer directly to the core text i.e., Upanishads or Bhagavad Gita, giving some useful direct quotations
- Use appropriate resources such as handouts, flip charts, PowerPoint Presentation etc.
- Show you are assessing that learning has taken place, e.g., checking understanding during the presentation, questioning group after presentation etc. concerning main point(s) conveyed.
- Take charge of the final discussion when the group will have the opportunity to ask questions and give you feedback.

**Please note** I will collect evidence as part of this assessment such as a copy of your teaching notes, any handouts, PowerPoint slides, a photograph of flip chart etc.

As part of your evidence there must be the inclusion of a bibliography summarising your research.

For each presentation I have suggested a few questions you may like to answer which could help you structure your presentation, but these are only suggestions to help orientate you to the task and you can go another way if you wish. Also, it may help to decide upon a couple of central points you want to focus upon as the key points of learning to be conveyed.
